SUMMARY

Software engineer who got here through operations. I ran the P&L for a 400-unit storage portfolio, served as in-house product owner on its StorEDGE SaaS migration, then returned as the contract engineer to build the software I had wished for as an operator. Since July 2025 I have worked as an independent engineer: refactoring and deploying a production FastAPI/React application now serving a few hundred users, and building Backstop, a monitoring tool that catches downtime and bugs in AI-built apps. I work in TypeScript, Next.js, Python, and FastAPI/Django, hold the Google Associate Cloud Engineer certification, and am looking to bring the operator-plus-engineer combination in-house: solutions, implementation, or product engineering for teams whose users run real-world operations.

Jul 2025 – Present

- Refactored and redeployed a production web application for a client under NDA, serving 100–300 active users: replaced a dated site with a React front end on a FastAPI backend and integrated a content management system so the client's staff publish updates without a developer.
- Building **Backstop** (founder): a Next.js monitoring service that watches uptime and catches production bugs in AI-built apps (Lovable, Bolt, Replit builds on Supabase/Stripe/Vercel stacks). Pre-launch; waitlist live at getbackstop.app.
- Backend engineer on a pre-launch B2B marketplace (Express, React) connecting event vendors with venues, a matching problem I previously handled manually while coordinating 100-person events on the buyer side.

Contract Software Engineer | Saugerties Self Storage

Nov 2023 – Present

- Returned to a business I had managed to build the software it lacked: shipped a Next.js site with server-side rendering and structured data markup, tripling qualified inbound leads and reaching page-one local search results within a month of deployment.
- Still the business's engineer today: shipped a full redesign and SEO pass in May 2026 and maintain the production site on an ongoing basis.

Software Engineer Intern | Rithm School

Sep 2023 – Jan 2024

- Built a conference management module in Django giving administrators one interface for event scheduling, room assignments, and attendee tracking, replacing the manual spreadsheet process that had bottlenecked three prior cohorts.
- Extended the PostgreSQL schema through the Django ORM without touching existing enrollment or grading migrations; wrote 40+ Selenium end-to-end tests (login → registration → schedule-conflict resolution) that caught two regressions before release.

OPERATIONS LEADERSHIP

Operations Manager | AutoCamp Catskills

May 2023 – Jul 2025

- Restructured the Toast POS configuration and redesigned the kitchen expo flow, cutting average order-to-delivery time by roughly 3 minutes and raising F&B satisfaction in post-stay surveys.
- Managed a 10+ person team across front desk, F&B, and events; weekly training structure and feedback loop cut new-hire ramp time in half. Co-authored the annual operating budget on the Senior Leadership Team, holding food cost within 2 points of target.
- Ran on-property events end to end for groups up to 100; brokered branded merchandise partnerships with Hudson Valley makers that added 12% incremental retail revenue.

Operations Manager | Saugerties Self Storage

Nov 2021 – Mar 2023

- Owned P&L for a 400-unit, two-location portfolio, sustaining 70–95% occupancy through pricing adjustments, vendor renegotiations, and tight expense tracking.

- In-house product owner for a StorEDGE SaaS migration: coordinated the data cutover with the vendor’s engineering team, unified reservations, autopay, and e-leases through their API layer, and retired every manual spreadsheet. Monthly close went from a full afternoon to 30 minutes.
- Launched a new 150-unit facility with a multi-channel campaign (SEO, paid search, grassroots outreach), hitting 70% occupancy four months ahead of the pro forma projection.
